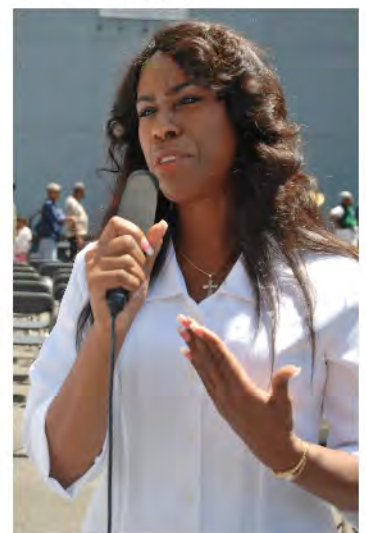


West Angeles Church is "Taking the Gospel to the Streets"
